## A Note from Fr. Keith, Our Pastor

Last week, our Music Director, Pat Mooney resigned as a staff member at our parish effective mid-August. I shared with Pat my gratitude for his talents as a musician, cantor, and choir director. Personally, I will miss his humor. On behalf of the parish, I wish Pat well in his future ministry. His departure is an opportunity to discern refreshing the responsibilities of this role to meet the real needs of the parish. For example, the parish audit last year identified a need to reduce connected expenditures like printing. We will be looking at various hymnal options. Please look for more updates soon.

What does the Church teach about music in the liturgy? Three years ago, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops published *Catholic Hymnody at the Service of the Church* as a summary and guideline for the role of music in the liturgy. The Preface reflects on the contribution of music to beauty which communicates the revealed truths of the very mysteries we celebrate and remember at Mass. They rightly acknowledge, the hymns at Mass “are among the most significant forces in shaping—or misshaping—the religious and theological” understanding of the faithful.

The bishops, exercising their responsibility to safeguard the liturgy, offer two questions as General Guidelines for selecting music at Mass. First, does the hymn conform to Catholic doctrine? Second, do the vocabulary and images of the hymn align with Scripture? Our selection of music at Mass should be inclusive of the entire patrimony of the Church. We should not artificially confine or limit ourselves to any one era or style. Familiarity or preference are secondary to doctrine and vocabulary.

With these guiding questions in mind, the bishops present six concerns or deficiencies. The most serious concern are the Eucharistic hymns with lyrics presenting errors about the Blessed Sacrament. They give the example of “All Are Welcome” which only references water, wine, and wheat instead of the Body and Blood. Second, they warn against Trinitarian confusion. For example, lyrics should make a clear distinction between Father, Son, and Spirit without referencing all Three Persons as a generic Creator. Third, the bishops caution against lyrics which confuse the relationship between God and human beings. Fourth, with great concern, the bishops give warning about lyrics which suggest the Church only has a human element while ignoring the Saints or the Mystical Body of Christ. They use “Sing a New Church” as an example of this error. Fifth, they lament about lyrics which demean Judaism, the chosen religion of Jesus and his Apostles. They give “The Lord of the Dance” as an example with an antisemitic verse sarcastically blaming the Chosen People for the Crucifixion. Finally, they caution against anthropologically incorrect hymns which may deny the Resurrection.

In this second year of the Eucharistic Revival, it is vitally important we celebrate Mass with intentionality. Remember, how we pray reflects what we profess to believe. So, if we believe in the True Presence, then our hymns should demonstrate that belief in the lyrics. Saint Augustine is often quoted as saying, “He who sings, prays twice.” May our twofold prayers be pleasing not only to us who sing but also to God who listens.
