# A Note from Fr. Keith, Our Pastor

Every year on this Third Sunday of Advent a well-meaning parishioner, usually male, makes the same or similar joke to the priest and deacon about wearing "pink." Most people only notice the change in color for the vestments and wreath candles without knowing the deeper meaning or significance for this change. "Pink," or more accurately rose, is more than just a color selection or preference; it is rooted in the ancient tradition of the Church.

We rejoice this weekend as the celebration of Christmas draws nearer. The Entrance Antiphon for the Third Sunday of Advent comes from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Philippians when the Apostle Paul encouraged them toward joy, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near." This is translated from the original Latin text, *Gaudete in Domino semper*, which begins with the imperative. We are being commanded, in a grammatical sense, to rejoice.



As above, this hortatory anticipation is reflected in the change to rose vestments as a lighter shade of violet. The alleviation of the penitential character of this season points to Christmas as a reminder that our preparations should be characterized by joy. The Third Sunday of Advent is called *Guadete* Sunday or "Rose Sunday" in reference to the coming joy. Pope Francis once preached that *Gaudete* Sunday is known as the "Sunday of joy", and that instead of fretting about "all they still haven't" done to prepare for Christmas, we should remember all the good things God has already given us.

This season concludes with the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Uniquely, Christmas Eve falls on the same Sunday this year. Unfortunately, Mass attendance for the Fourth Sunday is expected to be very light. Therefore, we decided to combine the usual morning Masses. <u>As a reminder, Sunday Mass next</u> <u>weekend will be at 10am.</u> There will not be both a 9am and 11am. Mass will only be at 10am in a simpler form without music or assisting ministers to give our wonderful volunteers a much-deserved and needed break before Christmas Eve. This one-time change has been advertised and announced on our website, bulletin, and Flocknote for several weeks.




